

#### Telephones/Cell Phones Electronic Device Usage

GOAL: To provide our students the opportunity to make responsible, wise decisions when using cell phones and/or electronic devices. \*We will not allow cell phones, electronic devices or the social media sites connected with electronics to interfere with or disrupt the educational process

- Students may only use their cell phones/electronic devices on the bus, during their designated lunch period in the cafe/west terrace, and before/after school.
   Cell phone use of any kind is prohibited in all other areas during school hours.
- Student use of cell phones, or other electronic devices during the school day is a *privilege*, *not a right*. Abuse of this *privilege* can result in the *Zero Tolerance Policy* invoked by the Principal or designee on an individual and/or school-wide basis

#### **Attendance**

#### ABSENCES, LATENESS, AND DISMISSAL ATTENDANCE

- "Regular attendance and promptness are essential for academic and technical success. All Whittier students are expected to be in school and in all classes whenever school is in session.
- "Students who are absent ten or more days in a school year will result in all loss of credit and failure for the school year. Family vacations and trips are not permissible during school time.
- "Upon reaching the fifth absence, parents/guardians will be notified and students may be required to have a hearing with the Principal or designee, Guidance Counselor and their parents/guardians.

**APPEALS PROCESS** - In some cases , a student or parent/guardian may have good cause to appeal due to extraordinary illness or circumstances. The appeal must follow the process outlined below:

- -Written request with supporting documentation
- -Principal will review documents and **past history** and render decision in writing to uphold or deny the appeal.

**Dismissals** - A written note must be submitted to the Assistant Principal's office at the beginning of school for student dismissals. Students should not bring a phone text or try to call their guardians in the office to get dismissed. We do know their are circumstances that may arise and will work with all families so their student can get dismissed.


- WT has been a 1:1 school for 8 years
